Rinneadh obair chapaill in eagrú na hócáide agus táimid ar fad thar a bheith buíoch do Mhairéad Uí Shúilleabháin agus an coiste iontach as an obair mhór seo a rinne siad. Tá aiseolas an-dearfach faighte againn agus bhí atmaisféar iontach le brath san óstán an oíche sin. Bailíodh breis agus €20,000, méid nach beag do chiste na scoile agus beidh coiste forbartha á bhunú i ndiaidh an bhriseadh chun aghaidh a thabhairt ar an tionscnamh nua atá againn forbairt a dhéanamh ar halla na scoile. A most enjoyable evening was organised in Clontarf Castle on the 7th October.
