Páirceáil / Parking

Tá fadhb mhór againn le páirceáil arís taobh amuigh den scoil go háirithe ar maidin. Leagtar amach cón ionas nach bpáirceálfadh caranna sna spásanna sin ná ar na línte buí. Gach maidin bíonn carranna páirceáilte trasna an gheata nó ar na línte buí rud nach bhfágann aon spás do na busanna tarraingt isteach, nach dtugann radharc an bhóthair do pháistí ag trasnú agus a chuireann bac le múinteoirí na scoile teacht isteach sa charrchlós. Is fuínn ar fad bheith freagrach agus airdeallach sula ngortófar páiste ag geataí na scoile de bharr iompair an mhionlaigh. Iarrtar ar gach duine bheith airdeallach agus spásanna mairceáilte ag na cón agus na línte buí a fhágáil saor ó charranna. Roinn an teachtaireacht seo le bhur dtoil le gach duine a bhíonn ag fágáil páistí ag an scoil.

We have a big problem with parking again outside the school gates particularly in the morning time. Cones are laid out so as cars will NOT park in these areas or on the yellow lines. Every morning cars park across the gate or in the spaces provided for the buses indicated by the yellow lines. This prevents the buses from pulling in, restricts children's view and prevents teachers' cars from entering the carpark. It is our collective responsibility to be alert before a child is seriously injured by the behaviour of a minority. This message should be conveyed to everyone dropping children to school: to respect the areas designated by yellow lines and cones as being car free.
