An Mhaidin ar Scoil

Is é 8.50 am oifigiúil oscailt na scoile. Tá socrú i bhfeidhm againn sa scoil cúram a dhéanamh do na páistí sa chlós ar maidin le cabhair mhór ó thuismitheoirí. Ba chóir do gach páiste a thagann isteach ar scoil roimh 8.55 dul go dtí an clós tríd an halla áit go ndéantar an fheitheoireacht. Má thagann tú isteach le do pháiste ar maidin ba chóir iad a fhágáil ag an halla áit a fhágann siad na málaí i línte agus leanann siad amach go dtí an clós. Níor chóir go mbeadh tuismitheoirí fanta sa chlós, sa halla ná sna pasáistí ach amháin iad siúd atá ainmnithe agus clúdaithe le bheith ann ar laethanta áirithe.

An Mhaidin ar Scoil

The school officially opens at 8.50. We have undertaken to open the gates at 8.40 to mind children who arrive early in the yard with the much appreciated help and co-operation of parents. All children who arrive at school before 8.55 should go to the yard through the halla where they will be supervised. School bags should be left in the halla before continuing to the clós. Only those parents who are assigned to supervision duty on a particular day should be in the yard, halla or corridors.

If your child is late for school (after 9.10) the rule is that they are signed in in the secretary's office explaining the reason for they being late. This also applies to children who leave the school before the end of the school day, they must be signed out with an explanation. In the case of children attending medical appointments it is important to sign them back in on their return.

Please note that the official roll is registered at 10.00 each day and that a child will be marked absent if not in attendance then.
